

Please read the following rules carefully before contracting ice and make sure your skater is familiar with them, as they will be strictly enforced.

- All skaters must be contracted in advance: MAX 2 SESSIONS PER DAY per skater (more sessions will be offered to skaters after all waitlisted skaters have been accommodated).
- Maximum of 15 skaters on ice with a rate of \$15 per hour (\$12 for 45min)
- Club Ice sessions are limited to 1st Club Members (2nd club members may be offered sessions at a rate of \$18/hour or \$14/45min after all waitlisted skaters have been accommodated)
- NO Walk-ons and NO Switches or Refunds for missed sessions
- Coaches may be in the stands spread out in sections around the rink and up to 3 coaches may be on the ice at any given time.
 - Coaches should wipe down the area of the stands they used when they leave
- Skaters may only use designated chairs in lobby or club room and must stay within marked areas
 - Skaters should wipe down their chair when they leave
- Skaters and coaches **must wear masks** as per the current public health and rink requirements.
- No parents in the building unless designated by the Board as the supervising adult when no coach can be present
- Skaters and coaches may enter rink no sooner than **5 minutes before** the ice session starts and must leave **5 minutes after** the ice session ends.
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- If skating more than one session, skaters must leave the rink between sessions for rink staff to clean (if weather and time do not permit skaters to leave during the break they must maintain social distancing and wear a mask while in the rink)
- Skaters taking items rink side may only place items in designated 6-foot space on boards (only 1 skater per area)
- Skaters, coaches, and families need to maintain social distancing (remain 6 feet apart whenever possible) including when on the ice, inside, or outside of the rink.
- Do not enter building if you have ANY of the following symptoms:
 - temperature above 99.9°
 - new fever
 - cough
 - sore throat
 - shortness of breath
 - loss of taste or smell

As a reminder, Skaters, Families, and Coaches must follow FSCM and MII guidelines or lose ice privileges (without refunds). We have asked the rink staff to enforce these rules for us since we can not have an ice monitor.

Skaters not wearing a mask will face the following consequences.

- 1st offense- Warning and asked to immediately comply
- 2nd offense or non-compliance with warning – must leave rink for the day without refund
- 3rd offense or non-compliance as stated above – loss of ice privileges for the entire week with no refund
- 4th and final offense – loss of contract/skating privileges until mask requirement is lifted.

Skaters must respect these rules, their fellow skaters, and the rink staff who are looking out for the best interest of the entire skating community!
